#### **Procedure will be performed during the Sydney workshop**

Based on feedback from our physician members, more and more patients from late 20s to early 40s are looking for non-surgical face lifting procedure to delay the actual surgical face lift. However, there are very few physicians who have mastered thread lift and other non-surgical face lifting techniques in Asia. As such, we hope to introduce above techniques into Australia through our master class on March 3-4, 2018. During the master class, below 5 procedures will be performed:

1. Cosmetic Application of Aqua Shine Injections to Increase Overall Appearance and Condition of the Facial Skin
2. Non-Surgical Eyebag Removal: The Solution with RF Cannula, Supertirnafo & Inch Thread
3. Application of RF Cannula for Removal of Deep Forehead Wrinkles
4. Ultra PCL Thread Lifting for Facial Volume Relocation and Lifting
5. Combination of Thread Lifting with RF Cannula for Jowl Line Correction

**\* patients will be accessed individually by doctors before deciding which procedure to take**

#### **Details of the Procedure**


**Ultra PCL** – is a face lifting technique using absorbable polycaprolactone threads, which last for 2 years and then decompose inside the skin tissue. It first became employed in aesthetic therapy after the Korea Food and Drug Administration (KFDA) was approved in Korea in 2011. PCL eventually get dissolved by the skin after 1.5-2 years and in the process induce collagen which lasts about one year. The procedure is highly effective in skin rejuvenation by inducing


collagen synthesis from stimulating fibroblast. Its merits in procedure are 1) minimal invasive treatment, 2) no downtime and 3) immediate effect. Due to these advantages, this treatment is very popular in Asia and CIS countries and is still gaining popularity rapidly into other continents as well.

Patient Before & After:




**Hiko PCL** – is a nose shaping and sharpening technique using absorbable polycaprolactone threads, which last for 2 years and then decompose inside the skin tissue.





**Air Aqua Shine** – is a face anti-aging and brightening therapy using Air Shine, a multifunctional device which injects compressed air to create cavities between dermis and epidermis and then injects hyaluronic acid or other solutions to improve skin's elasticity, smooth out wrinkles, moisturize and brighten the skin.



### **Patient Review**

As PCL thread lifting is still relatively a new technique in Asia, we would like to share one of the Patient Review that underwent PCL Thread Lift in Perth, Australia:

#### **The Perfect Thread Lift and Laser Treatment**

I would like to share my recent cosmetic enhancement experience in Perth WA. At 36, my face had begun to show signs of ageing. Like most Australians, I have a lot of sun damage in my younger years and I have tried Botox before. I looked in to various treatment options available

to fix my sagging face and decided to explore the thread lift option. I think I was not ready to have a face lift surgery. And the idea of having a small day procedure without general anaesthesia and very little down time and affordable cost really ticked all the boxes. There are a lot of doctors doing this procedure in South Korea but I couldn't find much information about it from Australian websites. There are just 1 or 2 good clinics in Perth offering this procedure. I decided to choose the one with best before & after gallery and experience in using absorbable threads. I did not want permanent sutures in my face.

Pre, during and post procedure, he made me feel very comfortable and ensured that I understood every part to the procedure, which was remarkably pain free. I had a combination of PCL soft threads put in my mid and lower face to lift the somewhat sagging jawline. I also opted to have a fraxel repair laser peel to reduce sun damage on my face.

It's now been two days and I'm already able to see the results as my sagging face is all lifted as it used to be when I was in my 20's. I have been advised that fraxel peel has a down time of about 5 days and my face is still a bit red. There is very little discomfort. The post laser treatment balm given to me has been extremely helpful in keeping the area moist as I feel that fraxel laser really dries the skin.

Patients of all ages are welcome but older patients between age 30-50 stand a higher chance to be selected by faculty group as the improvement will be more obvious.
